

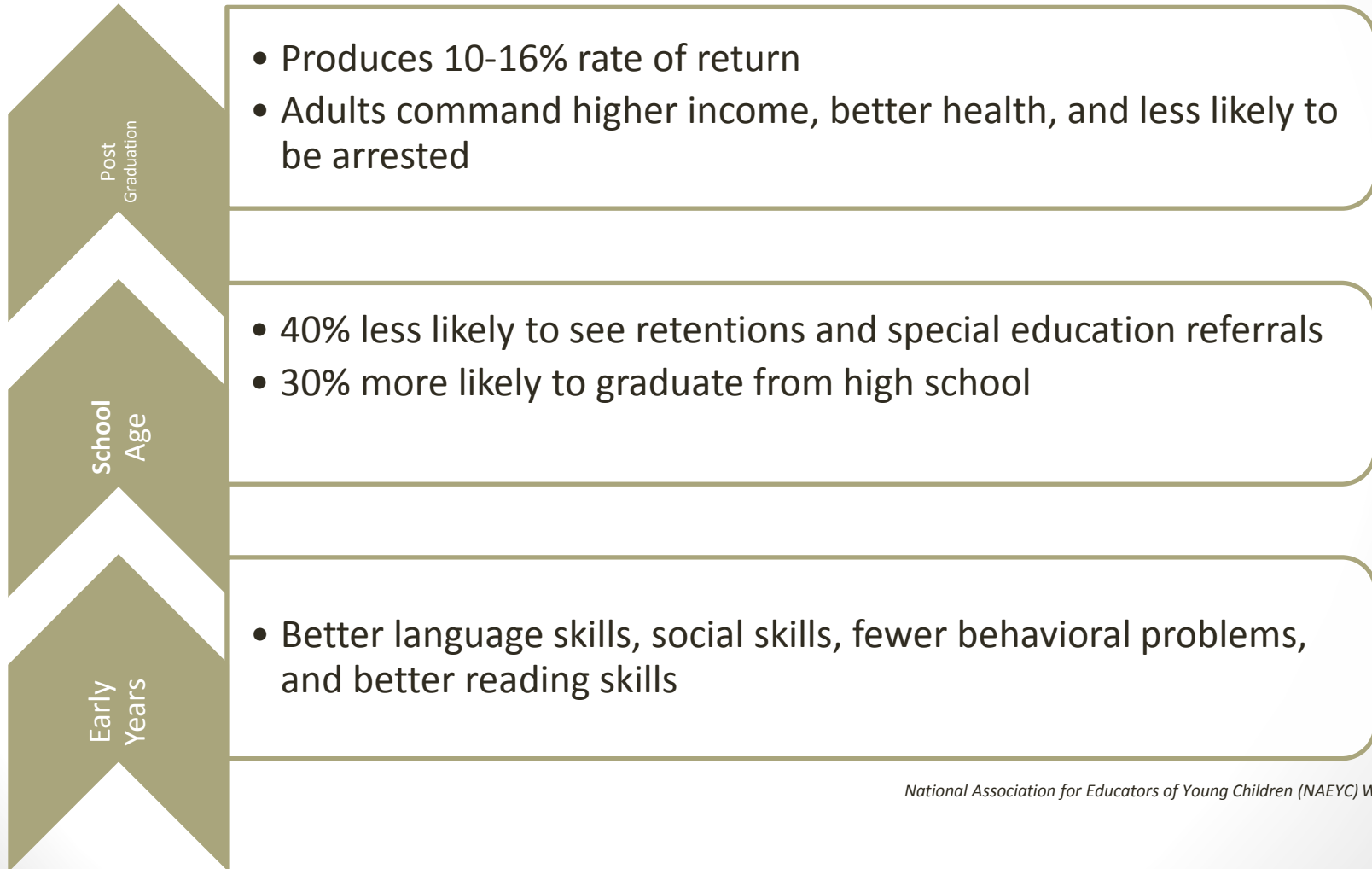

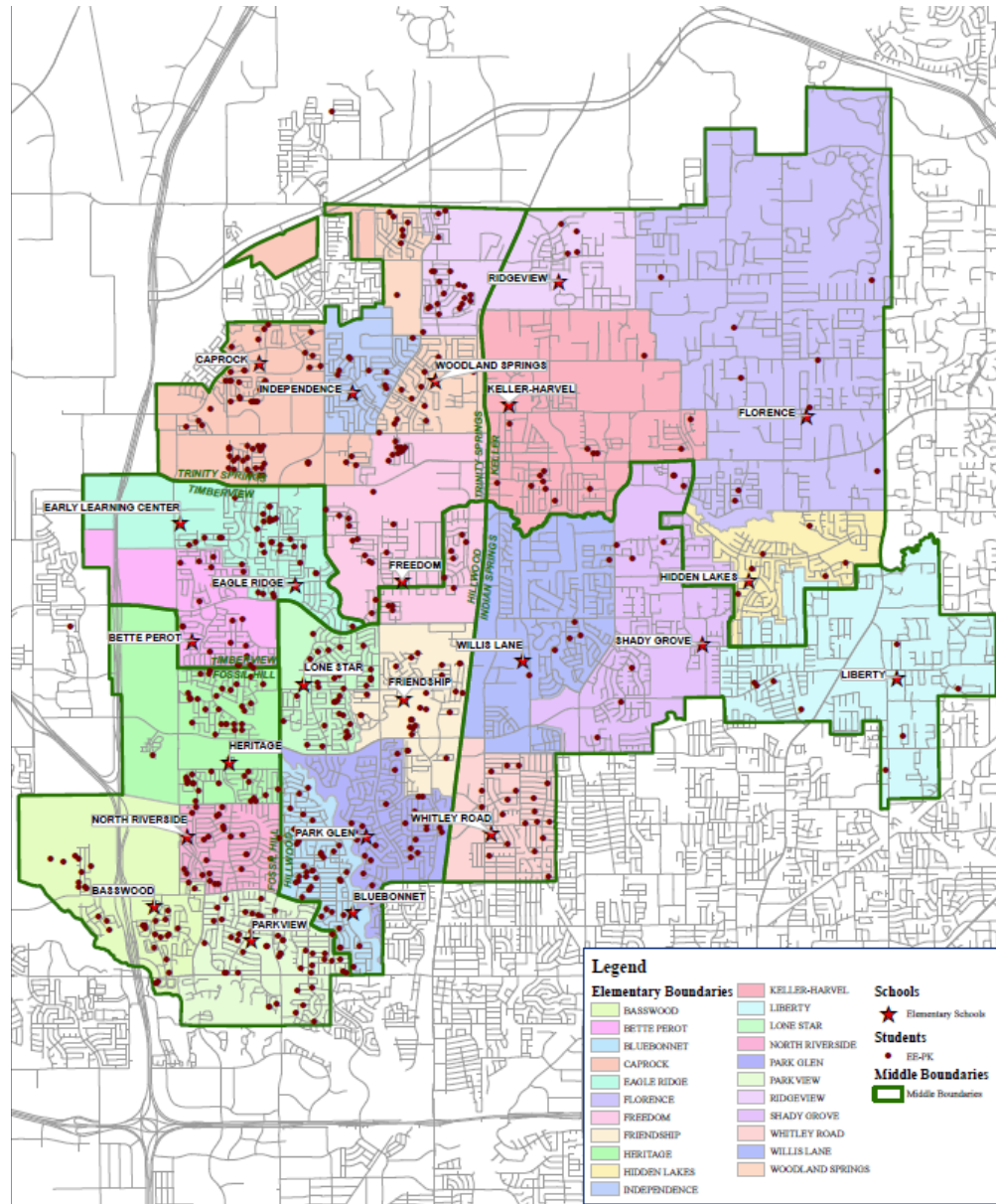

Preschool Program for Children With Disabilities (PPCD)

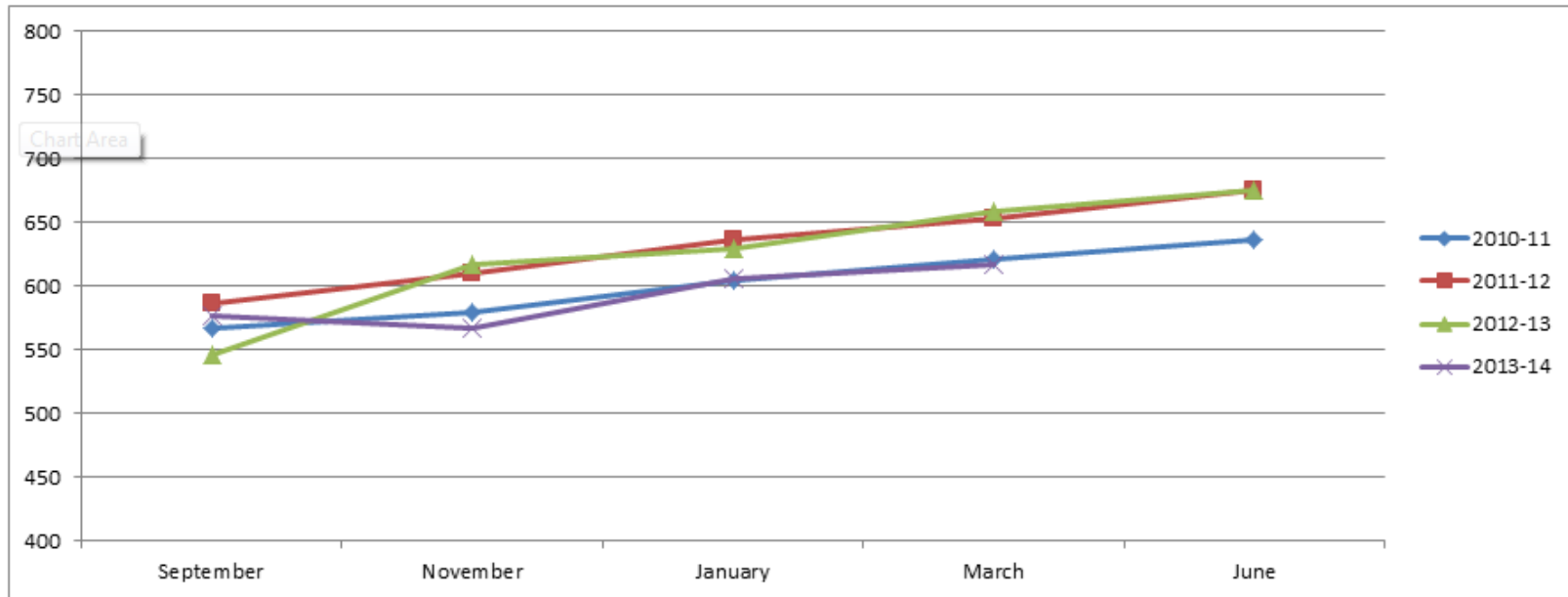
Eligibility Requirements:

- 14 Students enrolled in the past 14 days

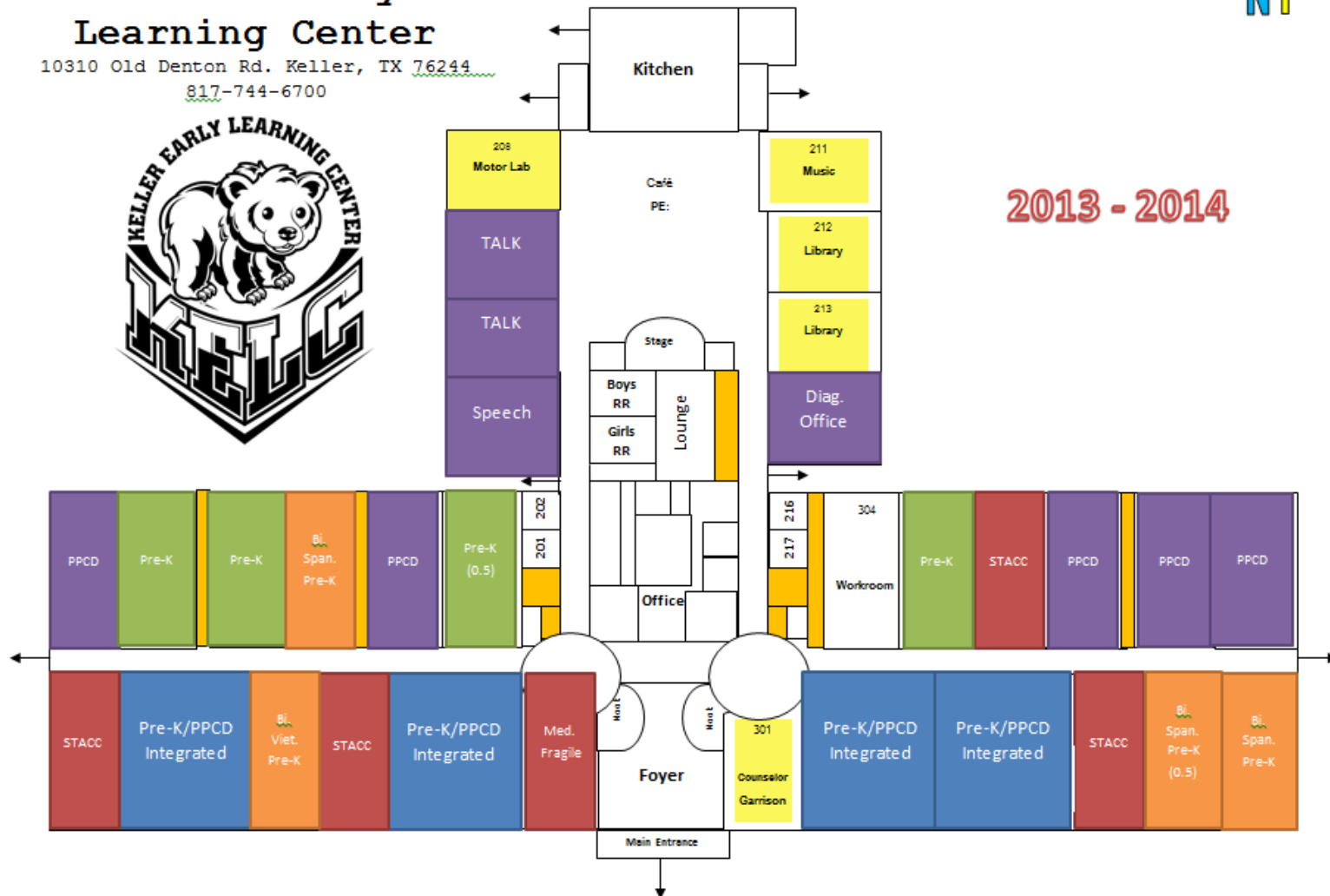
