- Non-example - School Board (voting aspect)

CHARACTERISTICS:

- Open dialogue regarding processes, systems, resources
- Protocols for soliciting feedback for improvement
- Ambassadors for the ROCK campaign in the community

NON-CHARACTERISTICS:

- Personal agendas
- Focus on individual situations versus all students
- Focus on punitive consequences
