We thank you for your support and continued involvement in our work during the 2023-2024 school year. We have included our end-of-the-year information below.

BACKPACKS/LOCKERS:

Safety is our most important priority. As we enter the final weeks of school this year, please review the expectations below with your student.

- **No backpacks, athletics bags, or duffle bags will be allowed on campus the last week of school after Friday, May 17.**
- No athletic lockers will be available for usage after Friday, May 17.
- Beginning May 20, students must leave the building immediately at the 4:00 p.m. bell unless in a tutorial session with a teacher. There will be limited scheduled after-school activities on campuses after 4:00 p.m.

Any backpacks, athletic or duffle bags will be stored away during the school day, and students will not have access to them until the end of the day. Please leave all bags at home.

EXAMS / EXEMPTIONS:

Tuesday, May 21 Exams: 1st/8th (Regular school day)

Wednesday, May 22 Exams: 3rd/5th/7th (Early Release at 12:45)

Thursday, May 23 Exams: 2nd/4th/6th (Early Release at 12:45)

- Exams will **NOT** be given early - **students must take exams the day/time it is scheduled**
- Qualifications to be **EXEMPT**:
 - 85+ average in the course
 - NO ISS, OSS, or DAEP assigned
 - No more than 3 unexcused absences in 2nd - 7th period
 - No more than 4 unexcused absences in 1st & 8th period
 - Unexcused absence = ABS, PRN, TRU

- Students that qualify to be **EXEMPT** from their semester exam must be notified by their classroom teacher the **class period prior to the exam date**:
 - Monday, May 20 - 1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th, 8th periods

- Tuesday, May 21 - 2nd, 4th, 6th periods
- Exam exemptions are by class period. For example, students could be exempt in 4th period but not other classes based on absences and grades.

ATTENDANCE:

ALL students MUST be in attendance for exams

- **Failure to attend class on exam day will result in a ZERO for the exam grade.**
- **Any student** who is absent on exam day with an excused absence will be able to make up an exam with their counselor by **Friday, May 31st**
 - The student must make arrangements with their counselor
- If a student is **exempt AND is absent** (unless absent due to an excused absence)
 - They are no longer considered exempt
 - Will receive a zero
 - Make-up exam grade could lower their semester average
