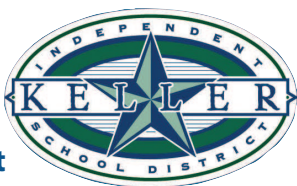

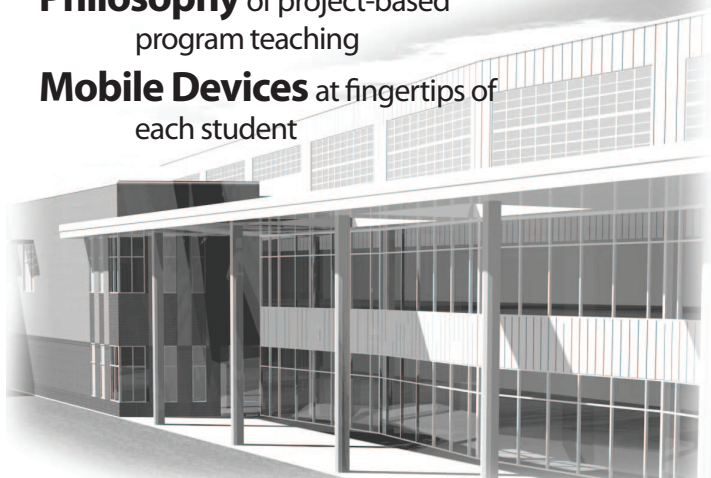

## Campus

The campus will **TRANSFORM** the traditional teaching-learning process. An innovative non-traditional learning culture will be created that combines the KISD core curriculum, the best of the most appropriate familiar and accessible technologies with research based and innovative instructional strategies. The goal is to create a learning culture that provides students with an instructional program specifically focused on their learning styles. Teachers, parents and the community will remain integral partners in this learning collaboration.

The campus will include **TECHNOLOGY** in every part of the learning process. KISD technology standards will be implemented in this building including wireless connectivity, document cameras and projectors, integrated electronic whiteboards, mobile computing devices, and an integrated online student-teacher-parent collaboration portal. In addition, the focus of this hybrid campus will be on one-to-one technology utilizing familiar and accessible technology with 24/7 access to learning resources.

The campus' **COLLABORATIVE DESIGN** was overseen by students, teachers and the community and provides alternative instructional spaces for small group and large group collaboration, individual and group technology use, spaces allocated for presentations, and better work flow.
