### **Texas Association of Secondary School Principals Awards & Recognitions:**

- **Region 11 Outstanding Principal of the Year Award – Kenneth Anderson, KLC**

Keller Learning Center (KLC) Principal Kenneth Anderson has been awarded as the Region 11 Outstanding Principal of the Year by the Texas Association of Secondary School Principals (TASSP). TASSP recognizes outstanding principals and assistant principals from the twenty regional education centers in Texas. As the Region 11 winner, Kenneth is eligible to compete for the Texas Principal of the Year title.

Kenneth was nominated for this recognition because of the ongoing improvements and outstanding results he has facilitated at the Keller Learning Center and New Directions High School, including a reduced recidivism rate in the disciplinary alternative education program, innovative counseling programs for students receiving campus services, and valuable connections to the Response to Intervention process District-wide.

- **State Executive Officer Recognition – Carrie Jackson, TMS**
