- TPRI/Tejas Lee meets the state requirement for the administration of an approved Early Reading Instrument for grades K-2.
- TPRI/Tejas Lee assessment results are used to revise district curriculum and instructional programs.
- TPRI/Tejas Lee assessments help classroom teachers tailor instruction for individual students, to group students for differentiated instruction, and to help students grow as readers.

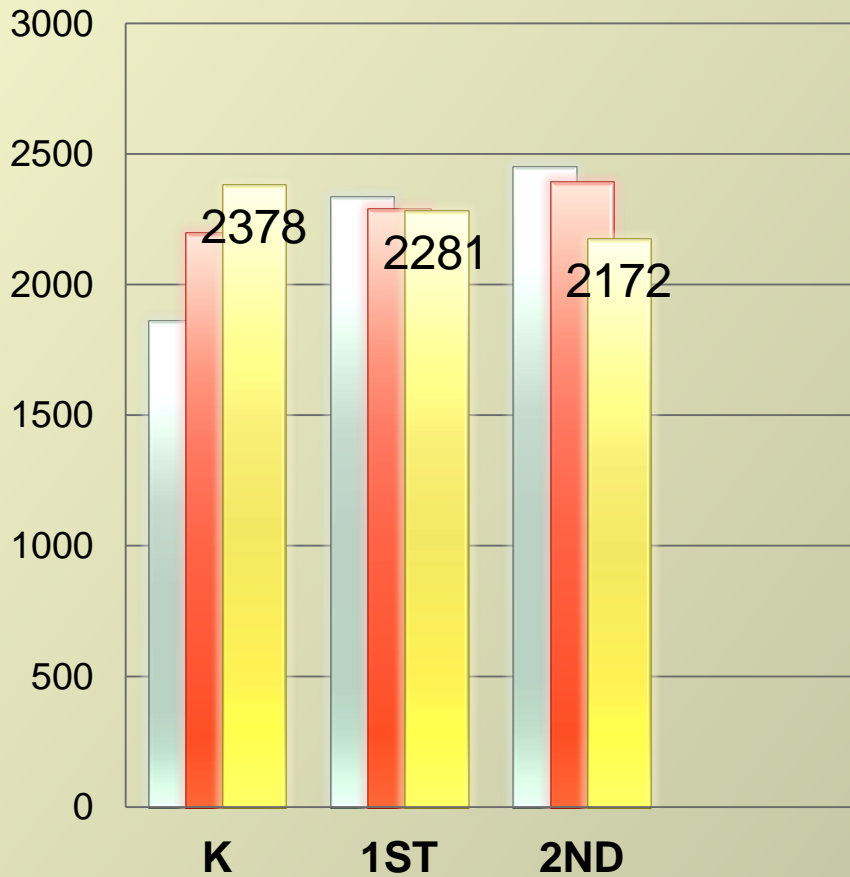

Number of Students Assessed

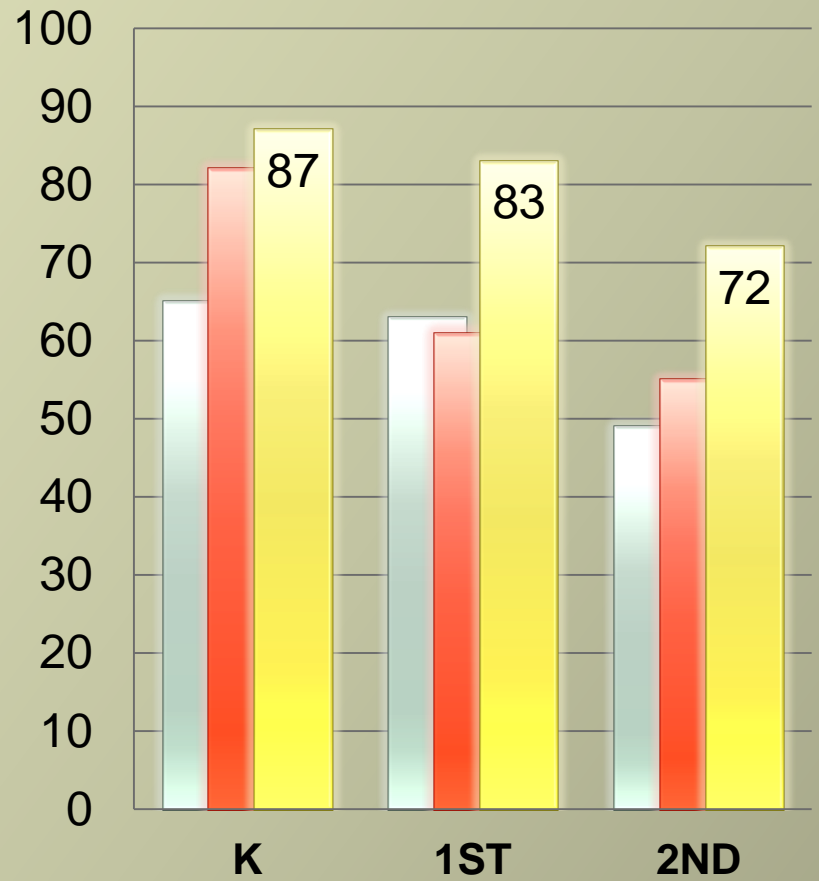

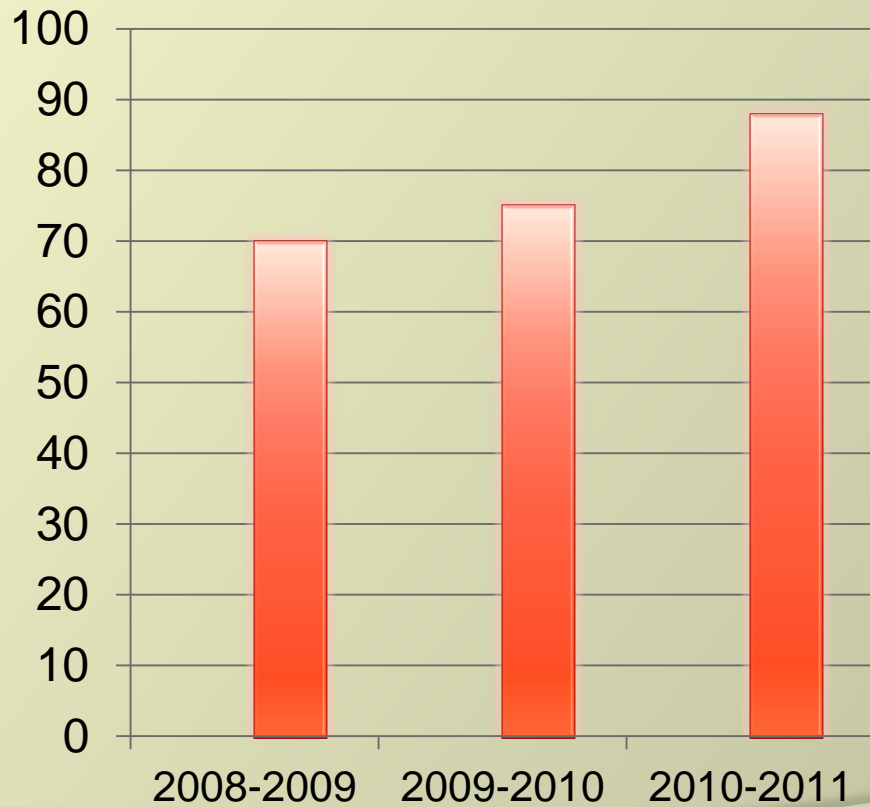

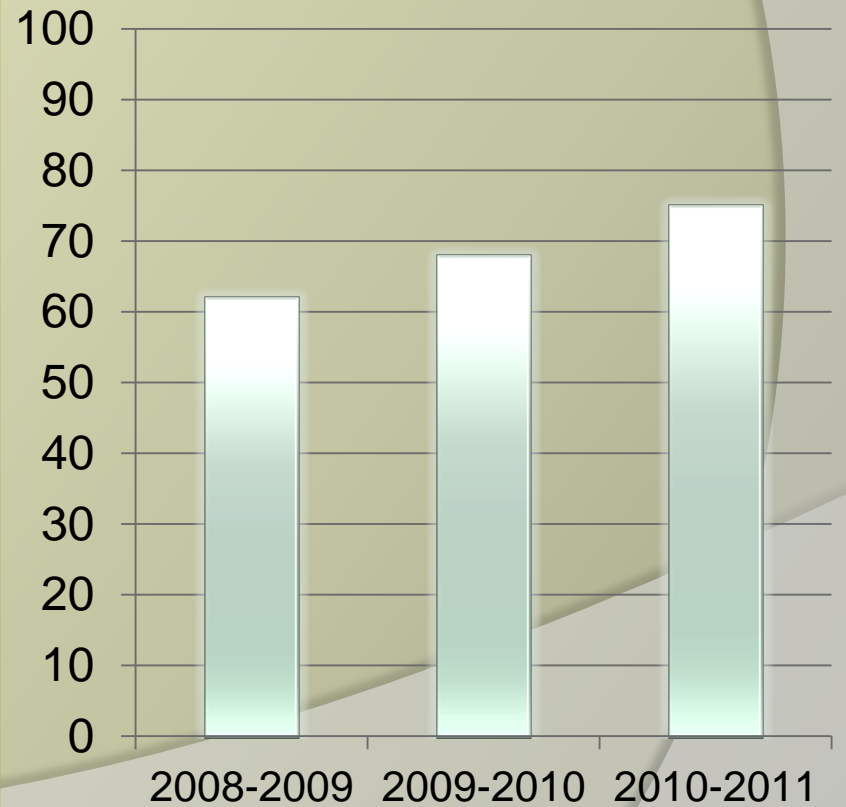


# Percentage of Students Meeting Comprehension Target

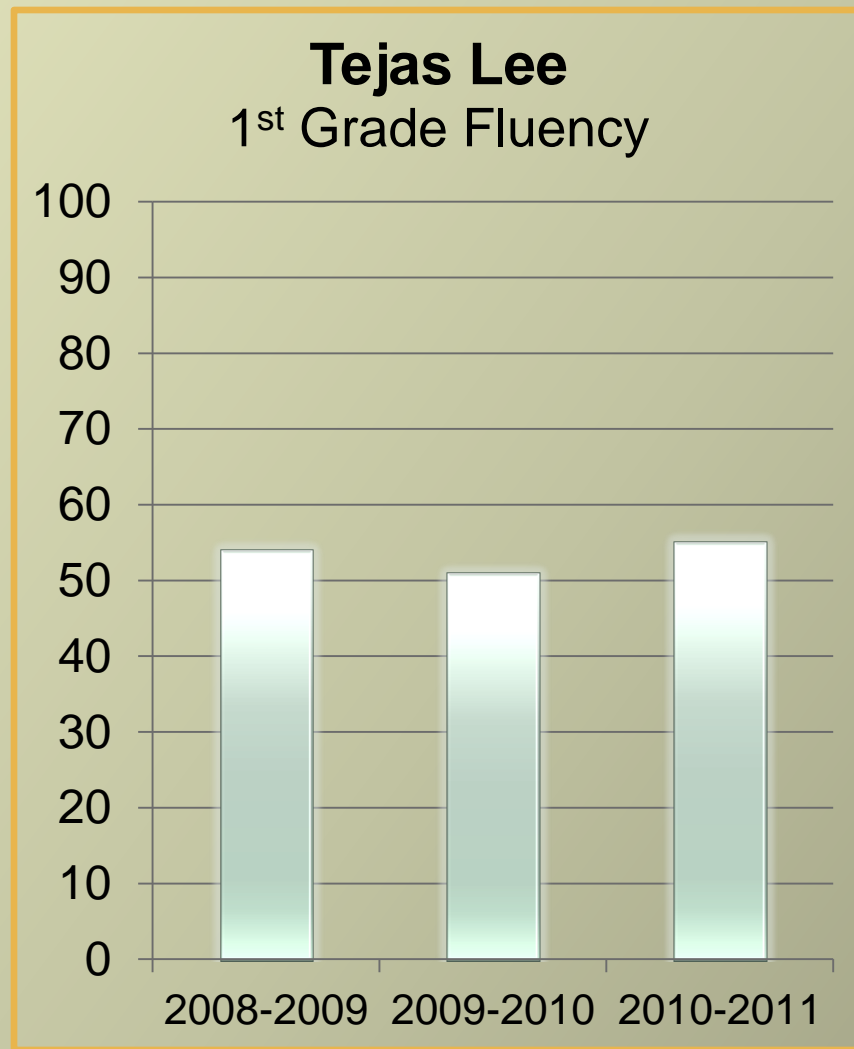
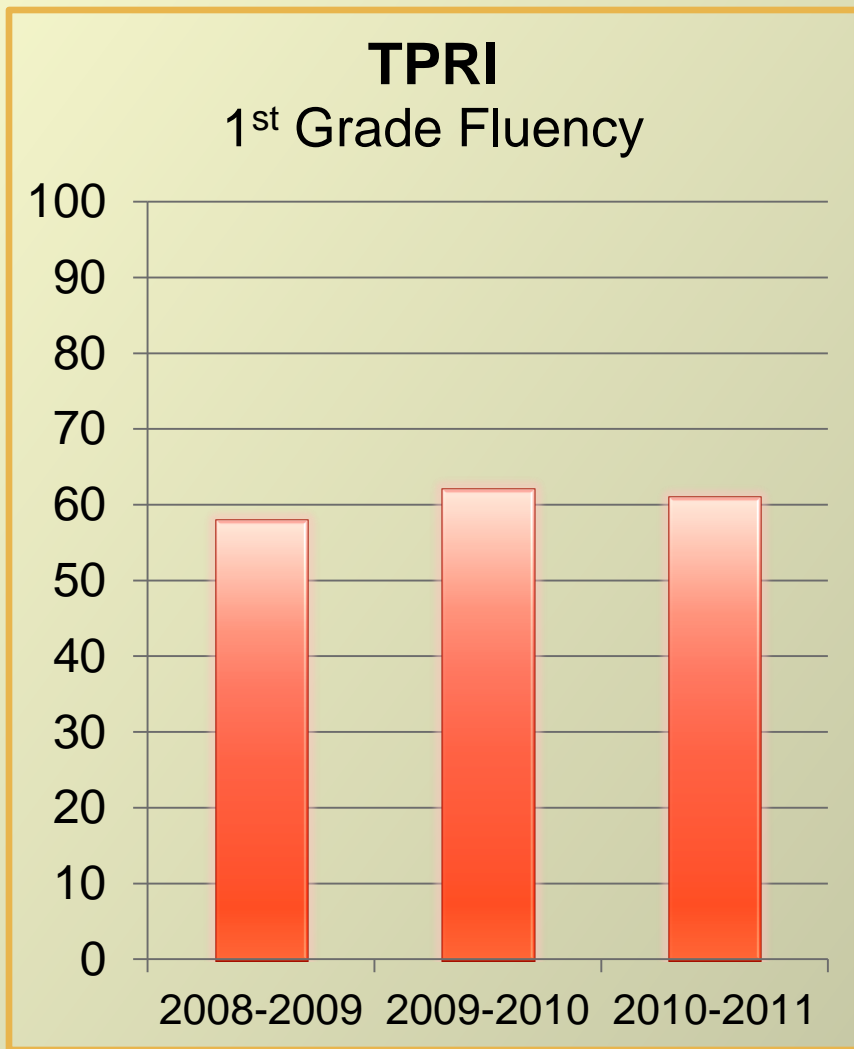
## TPRI Kindergarten Comprehension



## Tejas Lee Kindergarten Comprehension

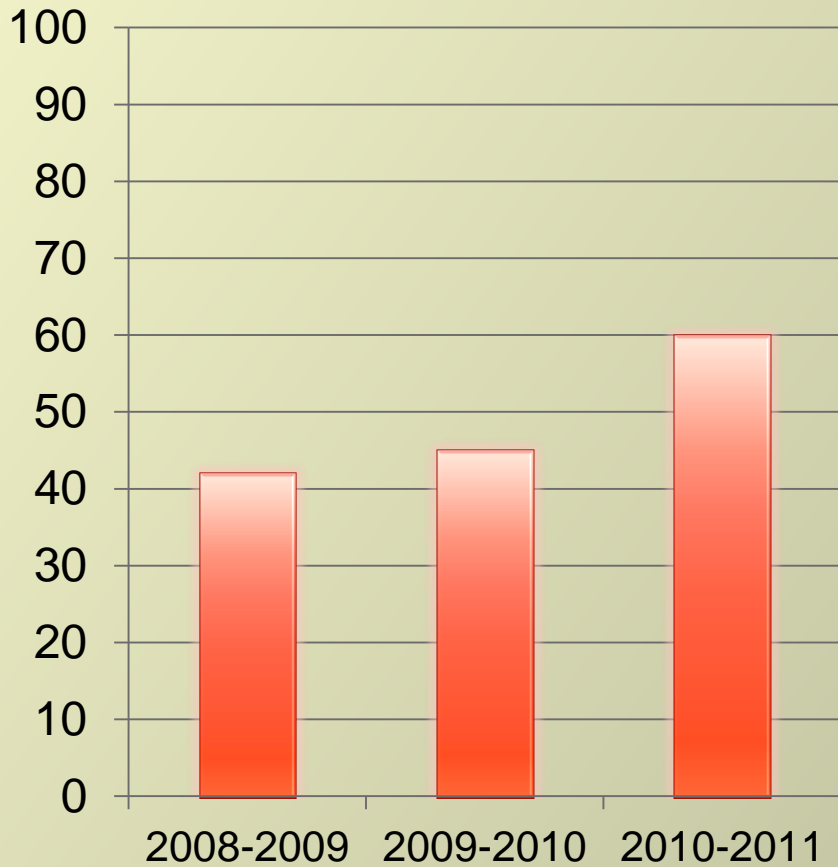


# Percentage of Students Meeting Fluency Target

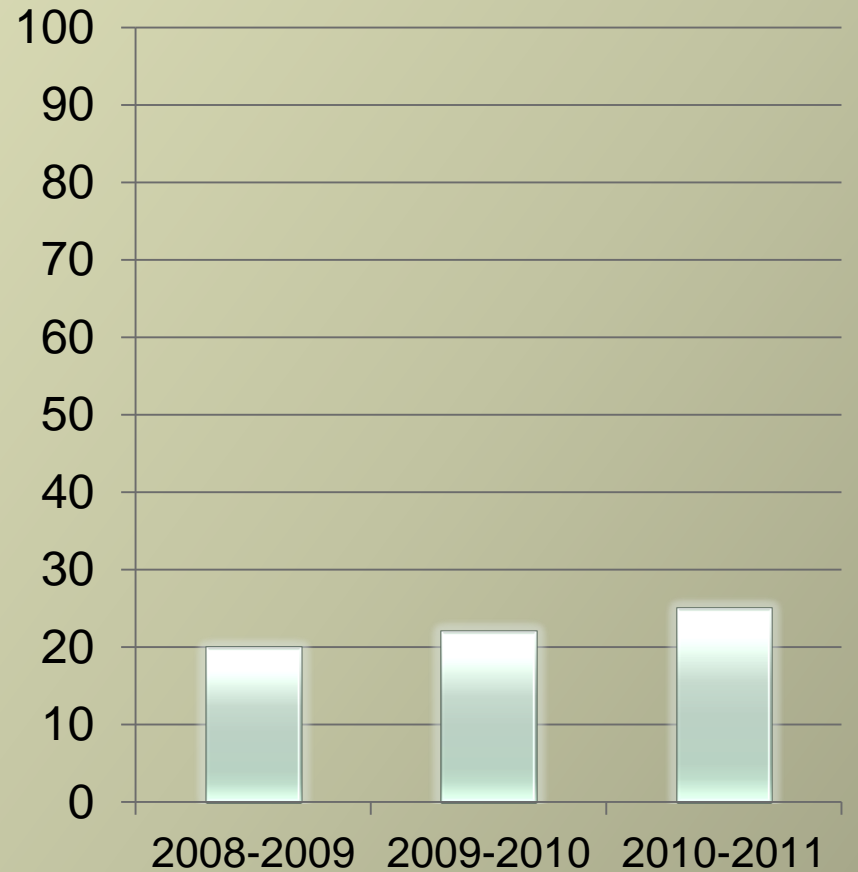


# Percentage of Students Meeting Fluency Target

## Tejas Lee 2nd Grade Fluency

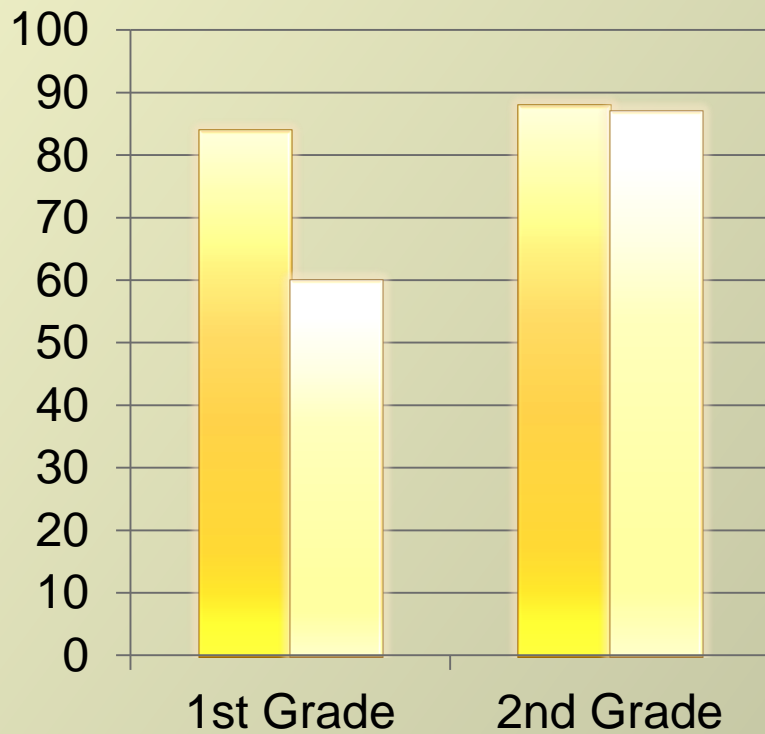


# Percentage of Students Meeting Comprehension Target
