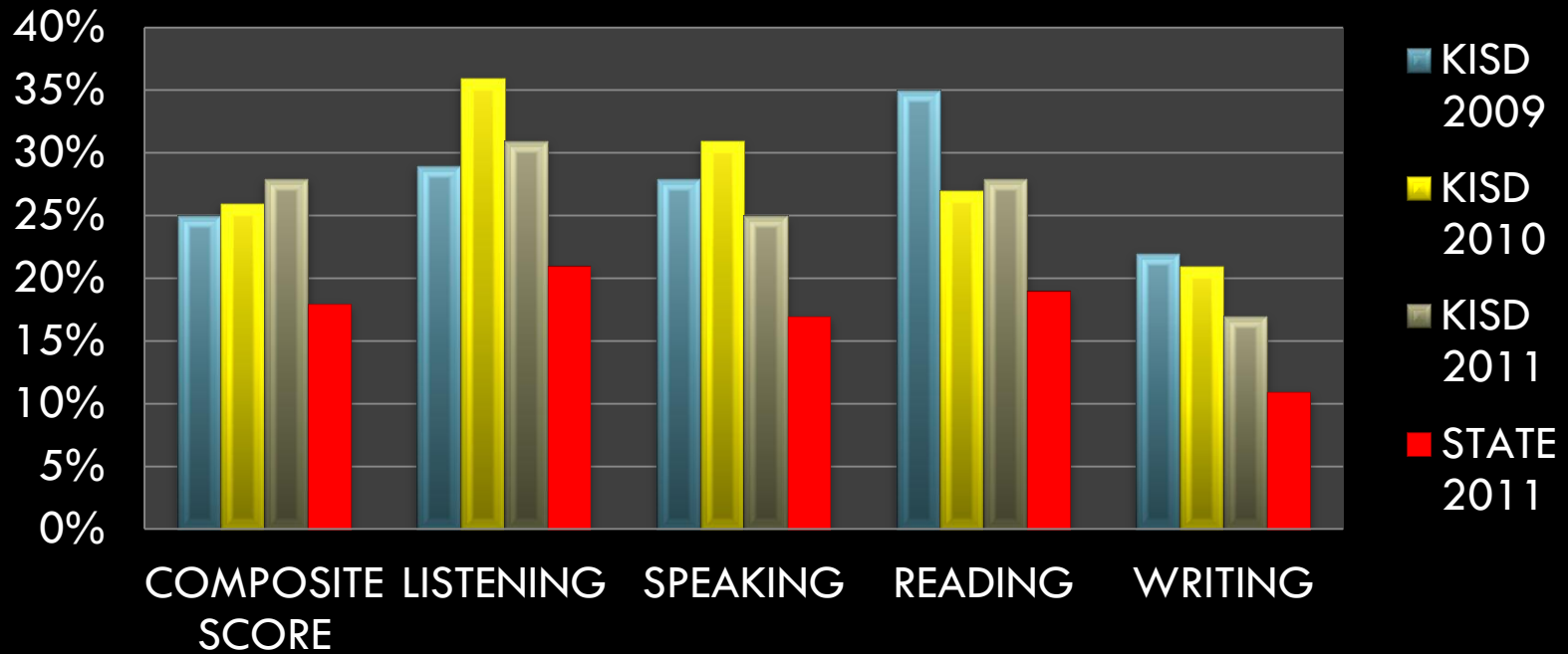

Texas English Language Proficiency Assessment System

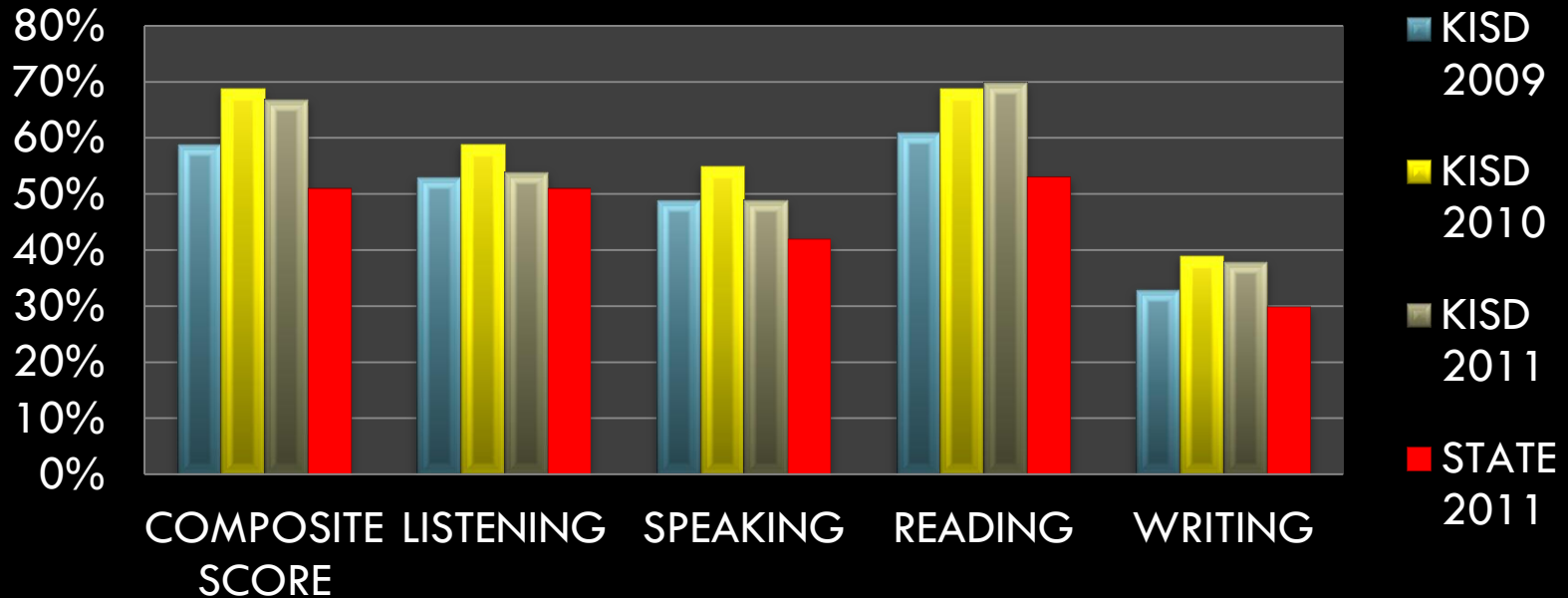
TELPAS is a required state assessment to measure English language acquisition of K-12 students who are identified as limited English proficient.
