The Keller Independent School District is sharing information about the district and your child's campus with you as part of its obligation under the federal No Child Left Behind Act of 2001.

The following information is now available on www.KellerISD.net on the Parents page under NCLB Report Card:

- Assessment results for the district and all campuses in the aggregate and disaggregated by race/ethnicity, gender, disability status, migrant status, English proficiency, and economically disadvantaged showing two-year (2006-07 and 2007-08) trend data for each subject and grade tested:
 - by performance level;
 - with a comparison between annual objectives and actual performance for each student group, and;
 - including the percentage of each group of students not tested.
- Graduation rates for secondary school students.
- Performance of KISD and all campuses on adequate yearly progress (AYP) measures.
- Number and names of Title I schools identified as *in need of improvement*, including the state of improvement and AYP indicator missed.
- Professional qualifications of teachers in the district, including the percentage of teachers teaching with emergency or provisional credentials and the percentage of classes in the district and on any campuses that are not taught by highly qualified teachers, including a comparison between high- and low-poverty campuses within the district.
