



Texas High School Graduates from FY 2009

Enrolled in Texas Public or Independent Higher Education in FY 2010

- Texas statute (TEC §51.403) requires every district to include with its AEIS report a report on student performance in postsecondary institutions during the first year enrolled after graduation from high school. The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) posts this data (*Annual Texas Success Initiative Texas Higher Education Assessment/Alternative (THEA/A) Test Report of Student Performance*) on its website at: <http://www.txhighereddata.org/Interactive/HSCollLink.cfm>
- This information is provided to districts from the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB), reports on student performance in postsecondary institutions during the first year enrolled after graduation from high school.
- Student performance is measured by the Grade Point Average (GPA) earned by 2008-2009 high school graduates who attended public four-year and two-year higher education in FY 2010.
- This report attributes students to the level of institution where they earned the most semester credit hours during the whole academic year, not just the fall semester.
