The Texas Application for Student Financial Aid (TASFA) is an application that determines whether undocumented/ DACA students are eligible for state or institutional financial aid. Students must be a Texas resident.

VERIFICATION

- 2020 Tax Return Transcripts / 1040
 - You can request your transcripts at <u>www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript</u> with the following information
 - SSN or Individual Tax Identification Number (ITIN)
 - Date of birth
 - Mailing address from your latest tax return
 - Estimated Wait Times
 - Filed Electronically: 5-10 days
 - Filed by Postal Service: 5-6 weeks
- ☐ Household size
 - Includes you and your family
- □ Residency Affidavit
 - Submit to the admissions office or contact each school for more information
 - Certifies you are a Texas Resident for instate tuition and for Texas Financial Aid.
- → Selective Service Card (Males 18 and older only)
 - Visit the <u>www.sss.gov</u> website to check for registration. You can also register at your Local Post office.
 - Make a copy of the Selective Service card and Submit for each TASFA application
 - If you are not 18, you should send the card the day you turn 18.
