### HOW IT WORKS:

Using specialized equipment and working with your child's school nurse, the Cook Children's nurse practitioner will be able to look in your child's ears and throat, listen to their heart and visually assess other symptoms. Strep and flu tests also can be performed. If necessary, a prescription can be sent electronically to your preferred pharmacy.

Both CHIP and Medicaid are accepted for payment. At this time, most private insurance companies don't pay for telehealth visits. If insurance doesn't pay and this is your first time seeing a Cook Children's physician, you will be charged \$65. If your child is already seen by a Cook Children's physician, the fee is \$50. If you have a health care savings

account (HSA), you may be able to request reimbursement from your HSA. If your child is uninsured, the rates will be the same as privately insured patients. Strep and flu tests will incur additional charges.

All parents/guardians are required to complete Cook Children's designated consents and acknowledgements for treatment and communication of patient information.

Cook Children's physicians and staff will follow the patient confidentiality and privacy policies of Cook Children's Health Care System. The telehealth video conference platform is HIPAA-compliant.

\*Pre-registration by the parent or guardian is
