

BEHAVIOR




- ★ Class Dojo will be used to earn points throughout the school day

GRADING


- ★ Progress Reports/Report Cards: Progress reports and report cards will be uploaded to Aeries.

GRADING

- ★ Grades in all subjects will have at least six Formative assessments (Daily Grades) and at least two Summative assessments (Tests/Summary of Work).
- ★ Students will be receiving number grades in the core content areas. (Conduct and Study Skills grades will remain as letter grades. E=excellent, S= Satisfactory, N=Needs Improvement, and U=Unsatisfactory)
- ★ Many of our grades will come from journals and items completed in class. Therefore, there will not be a large amount of papers sent home. Using Aeries to monitor grades will help keep you informed.
- ★ ELA grades will be taken from our reading/writing workshop time. We will use journals and post-it note activities to assess understanding.


