

ADVANCED ACADEMICS

- The Keller Independent School District secondary schools offer students the opportunity to participate in challenging academic courses, such as Accelerated (Acc), Advanced (Adv), Honors, Advanced Placement (AP), Dual Credit, and Dual Enrollment. Because these classes are college preparatory and/or similar to college-level courses, students are challenged to be more disciplined, structured, and to perform at a higher academic level.

What are Advanced courses? Advanced courses are intermediate and middle school courses that are designed to allow students access to a more rigorous level of curriculum engagement in a given core content area.

What are Accelerated courses? Accelerated courses are compacted curriculum courses that are designed to allow students access to a faster pace of curriculum in a given core content area.

What are Honors courses? Honors courses are high school college preparatory courses that are designed to provide students with the necessary skills to be successful in Dual Credit and AP courses. In KISD, these skills together with the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) comprise the syllabi for Honors courses.
