Keller Independent School District Athletics Department would like to take this opportunity and welcome your student-athlete into the athletics program. Our campus coaches and athletic trainers are looking forward to working with you and your student-athlete(s) during their athletic career.

The UIL packet contains the paperwork required by the University Interscholastic League and Keller ISD for student participation in athletics. Please take the time to read the information provided and fill out all the necessary forms. These forms provide the medical staff and the coaching staff with critical information required for your student-athlete(s) to participate in athletics.

We know it takes time and effort to fill out each different form provided. We understand your time is valuable, so let us say "Thank You" in advance for taking the time needed to make sure the forms are completed correctly. Each form will need a parent/legal guardian's signatures and as well as the student's. It is also essential to keep a copy of anything you may turn into the school by hand.

All Keller ISD students participating in athletics for the 2024-25 school year must get a UIL physical (dated any time after January 1, 2024) and fill out all appropriate medical and information forms. All KISD/UIL paperwork may be found at <https://www.kellerisd.net/athletics> under the "Required Forms for Athletics Participation." All paperwork is due May 22, 2024.

Note for incoming 7th graders: Required "Athletics Electronic Participation Forms" will be available online after July 8th.

If a student is unable to participate due to an illness/injury with proper documentation on file, they must bring a release clearing them for that injury. Please make sure you fill out the medical history form. Please note that the student AND parent must sign the form at the bottom of the page. If you mark "yes" to any questions on the medical history form, you "**MUST**" explain the answer in the box provided.

The University Interscholastic League and Keller ISD require packets to be completed and returned by the first day of the 2024-25 school year or the first day of your sport, whichever comes first.
