All students meeting the UIL requirements of promotion or earned credits toward state graduation are eligible. For example, Jr. High - for all students, promotion to the next grade means they are eligible for the first six weeks. 2nd year of high school, they need five credits. $3^{\text {rd }}$ year $=10$ credits. $4^{\text {th }}$ year $=15$ credits.
