


Q1 I have familiarized myself with recent conversations about Keller ISD's safety and security by viewing recent Board Meetings and/or reading the Superintendent's message.



Q2 I feel that my child(ren) is/are safe in Keller ISD schools.



Q3 I am satisfied with Keller ISD’s current safety measures (including door locks, visitor check-in procedures, drills, school resource officers).



Q4 When considering campus safety within Keller ISD, the following is the most important to me (rank in order of importance):



Contracting with a professional high-level security firm that offers customized security solutions and risk-mitigation services to hire nine (9) armed specialists that would each serve a small group of campuses in close proximity to one another (but not have an individual stationed at each campus). Implementing a program that would allow teachers and other officials to carry guns in schools similar to the Texas Department of Public Safety-certified program called Guardian, which would include a high level of training, evaluation, and oversight. 
