

## Bluebonnet Elementary School- Parent Compact

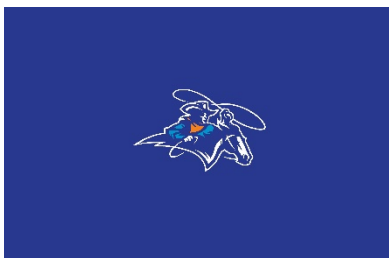
