Dear Parent or Guardian:

On Wednesday, **October 12th, 2022**, our campus will administer the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT). The PSAT is a standardized test that provides firsthand practice for the SAT. The PSAT/NMSQT has three parts: Reading, Math, and Writing & Language. The most common reasons students take the PSAT/NMSQT are to: help assess skills necessary for college-level work, prepare for the SAT, and enter competitions for National Scholarships (junior year), and receive information from colleges.

This year, all **tenth and eleventh** grade students will participate in this assessment and KISD will cover the cost of their exam. 10th and 11th grade students received study guides through their English classrooms. There are no registration steps required for these students. Freshmen who have paid will also test. Freshmen who paid should pick up study guides in the campus bookkeeper's office. **There are no further steps to register Freshman students for testing other than payment.**

Non testing students will report as follows:

- Seniors report to the Fine Arts Center at 11:45
- Non testing Freshmen report to the Main Gym at 11:45
- All non testing students may purchase a sack lunch in the cafeteria from 11:15-11:45
- Attendance will be taken for all students (Exemptions will be affected for non attendance)
