This allows the GKWC to direct its donations through the Foundation to non-profit organizations within our Northeast Tarrant County community, as well as the Scholarship Program benefitting each of the four Keller High Schools.

The Garden of Roses Fashion Show & Fundraiser, our annual fundraiser will be held at The Bowden Events & Weddings in Keller, Texas on March 23, 2019 with the help of over 200 club members. To date the foundation has given away well over a million dollars.
