
Keller ISD's Dual Credit Program is a way your student can earn college credit while in high school.

Our Dual Credit students take college-level courses taught by ful credentialed faculty. These courses **satisfy high school graduatic requirements** and **provide college credit** at the same time. The student receives **one grade** for the course.


AP VS. DUAL

	Dual Credit and Enrollment	Advanced Placement
Description	Allows high school students to simultaneously earn college credit, while also earning credit at their high school.	Allows students to take college-level courses and exams to earn college credit or placement while still in high school.
Credit	Guaranteed college credit upon successful completion of course(s) in Texas.	No guarantee upon completion of course(s); must pass College Board Exam AP exams with a score of 3 or higher.
Teachers / Instructors	Taught by college instructors or high school teachers who serve as adjunct professors.	Taught by the high school teachers trained by The College Board.
College / University Acceptance	Accepted at public college and universities in Texas as well as many other colleges and universities across the nation. Check the policy at each college or university.	Accepted throughout the nation. Check the policy at each college or university
Location	Taught at the high school, online or at a TCC campus.	Taught at the high school.
Eligibility	 Must be identified as a high school student. Must have high school approval. Must meet TSI eligibility requirements for college-level course work. 	Open to any student.
Cost	\$64 per credit hour (grant funds are available)	\$93 test fee (waivers may be available)

Dual Program Benefits

- 1. Expands academic options for college-bound students.
- 2. Shortens the time required to complete an undergraduate degree.

DUAL

- High School Credit and College Course Hours
- Agreement between ISD and Institution for Courses
- Courses offered on high school campus, TCC campus, or online.

CONCURRENT

- College Course Hours
- Complete on own time
- No opportunity for high school credit.
- Courses offered on
 TCC campus or online



TSI Assessment

(Texas State Initiative)

The TSI assessment is the approved placement test used by educational institutions to assist in determining if a student is prepared for a college-level course and to aid institutions in making course placement decisions.

PSAT Waiver

You must request to have your scores sent directly to TCC from either testing institution.



The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) is a <u>Federal law</u> that protects the privacy of student education records.

FERPA gives parents certain rights with respect to their children's education records. These rights transfer to the student when he or she reaches the age of 18 or attends a school beyond the high school level.



Students must submit a waiver of academic privacy before the college will release information.
