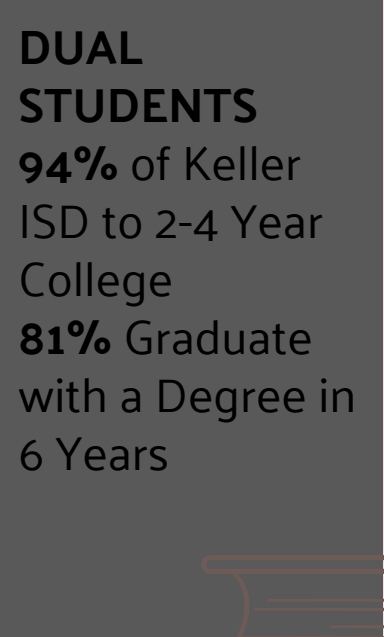

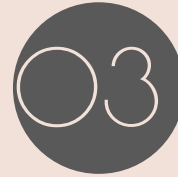

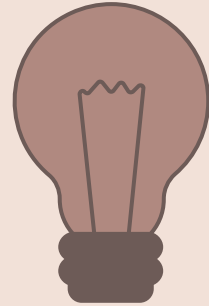

# AP VS. DUAL

	Dual Credit and Enrollment	Advanced Placement
<b>Description</b>	Allows high school students to simultaneously earn college credit, while also earning credit at their high school.	Allows students to take college-level courses and exams to earn college credit or placement while still in high school.
<b>Credit</b>	Guaranteed college credit upon successful completion of course(s) in Texas.	No guarantee upon completion of course(s); must pass College Board Exam AP exams with a score of 3 or higher.
<b>Teachers / Instructors</b>	Taught by college instructors or high school teachers who serve as adjunct professors.	Taught by the high school teachers trained by The College Board.
<b>College / University Acceptance</b>	Accepted at public college and universities in Texas as well as many other colleges and universities across the nation. Check the policy at each college or university.	Accepted throughout the nation. Check the policy at each college or university
<b>Location</b>	Taught at the high school, online or at a TCC campus.	Taught at the high school.
<b>Eligibility</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Must be identified as a high school student.</li><li>• Must have high school approval.</li><li>• Must meet TSI eligibility requirements for college-level course work.</li></ul>	Open to any student.
<b>Cost</b>	\$64 per credit hour (grant funds are available)	\$93 test fee (waivers may be available)

## Dual Program Benefits

1. Expands academic options for college-bound students.
2. Shortens the time required to complete an undergraduate degree.
3. Provides college credit.
4. Reduces the cost of higher education.
5. Begins their permanent college transcript.

- High School Credit and College Course Hours

- Courses offered on high school campus, TCC campus, or online.

## CONCURRENT

- College Course Hours
- Complete on own time
- No opportunity for high school credit.
- Courses offered on TCC campus or online

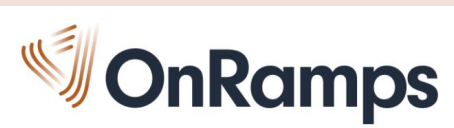

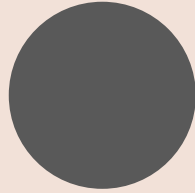

# TSI Assessment

(Texas State Initiative)

The TSI assessment is the approved placement test used by educational institutions to assist in determining if a student is prepared for a college-level course and to aid institutions in making course placement decisions. +



TSIA-2 Subject Area	Mathematics	English Language Arts and Reading
College-Ready Score	950; or less than 950 and Diagnostic Level 6	English Language Arts and Reading (ELAR) 945 M/C and 5 Essay; or less than 945 M/C and Diagnostic Level 5, and 5 Essay

The UT-On Ramps dual enrollment program does not require the TSI.

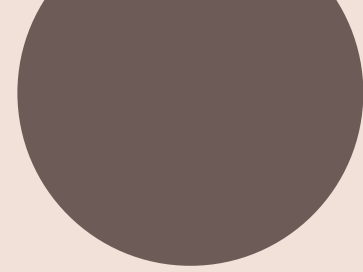

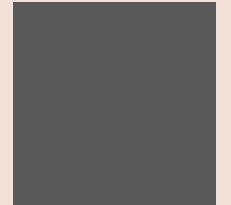
# FERPA

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) is a Federal law that protects the privacy of student education records.

FERPA gives parents certain rights with respect to their children's education records. These rights transfer to the student when he or she reaches the age of 18 or attends a school beyond the high school level.



**Students must submit a waiver of academic privacy before the college will release information.**

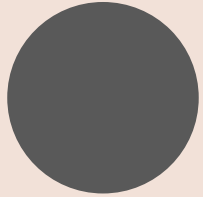
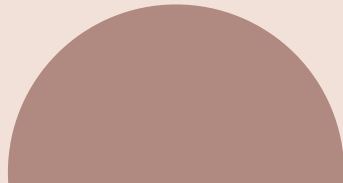

### TCC & WEATHERFORD

1. Register for course with Keller ISD during the SPRING course selection process.
2. Online registration Tarrant County College NW OR Weatherford College
3. Obtain a College ID #. Give ID# to your counselor.
4. Log-on to College email
5. Complete all registration steps with TCC NW or Weatherford College.

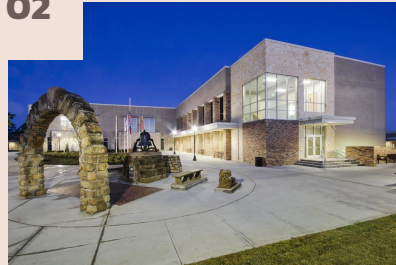
