Reading

- Readers ask and answer questions about topics.
- Readers compare and contrast across topics.
- Readers work hard to problem solve unknown words.
- Readers utilize background knowledge to preview and predict.

Word Study

- Use prepositions to name where something is located.
- Use complete sentences.
- Write legibly.
- Capitalize the first letter in a sentence.
- Use ending punctuation.
- Spell CVC words.

Social Studies

- Compare and contrast cultures from around the world.
- Use globes and maps to better understand the world.
- Learn to appreciate other cultures.

Math

- Students will develop an understanding of the numbers 11-20.
 - reading the numbers
 - writing the numbers
 - showing the quantity of the numbers using objects and pictures
- Students will practice reciting the number sequence from 0 to 100.
- Students will also be practicing counting forward and backward within 20 and without objects.

Writing

- Writers study informational texts.
- Writers implement step-by-step procedural directions.
- Writers use the structure of a How-To book.
- Writers generate precise and clear words.
- Writers demonstrate the importance of writing so readers can read their writing.

Questions to ask when reading at home:

- What do you think the book will be about?
- What was the main idea?
- Who are the characters?
- Where did the story take place?
- What was the problem?

Science

- Identify seasonal weather.
- Illustrate the objects in the sky.
- Explore the repeating patterns in the sky such as day and night and seasons.

Questions to ask about numbers:

- Which is more?
- Which is less?
- How many are there?
- Can you write the number?
- Start with any number and count up to 100.
