Who Needs An FSA ID?

The student will always need an FSA ID. At least one parent will need an FSA ID, depending on the following criteria.

If parents are married

If parents unmarried living together

If parents are divorced or separated not living together

If parents are married and file taxes together **one** parent will need an FSA ID

If parents are unmarried and live together, **both** parents will need FSA IDs

If parents are divorced or separated not living to the parent who provided more financial support in the last 12 months will need an FSA ID

If parents are married but don't file taxes together, **both** parents will need FSA IDs



If remarried, and parent and stepparent did not file taxes together, both parent and stepparent will need FSA ID'

The FAFSA considers the student's parent to be their legal (biological or adoptive) parent, whether or not they live with them. Do not include information about caregivers who are not biological parents, legal adoptive parents, or stepparents required by this chart.

What information do you need to create an FSA ID?

Full Legal Name

Email address (unique to you)

Date of Birth

Phone number (unique to you)

Social Security Number (if you have one)

Permanent address



Each email address and phone number can only be associated with one FSA ID. You will need access to the email account and cell phone at the time of account creation to complete account verification.

At the time of the 2024-2025 FAFSA opening, there will be a process for parents without a Social Security Number to create an account and verify their identity. Students must have a Social Security Number to complete the FAFSA. If your student does not have one, talk to your CCMR Counselor about applying with TASFA.
