JPS Health Network partners with school districts throughout our community to provide health services to students and their siblings. A school-based health center is a place where students can receive health care services for illness and to monitor chronic conditions such as asthma, diabetes and more. These centers are a great way to keep children healthy by providing health care in a convenient location close to school. Our goal is to work with your child's school nurse to keep your child healthy.

Not Just a Nurse's Office

When kids come into our school-based health centers, they're treated by a nurse practitioner or a physician assistant. These providers have additional training to diagnose and treat illnesses. They do everything a nurse can do and many things a doctor can do – things like conduct physicals, write prescriptions and treat your children when they're sick.

What We Do and Who We See

Students and their siblings, up to 22 years of age, can be treated at our centers. Children and adolescents under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian with them. Each child must go to the center in their school district. Siblings need not be of school age. We also teach kids about healthy eating and exercise and treat ongoing medical problems like asthma, diabetes, allergies and even acne.

We've Got Your Child Covered

If you don't have insurance, don't worry, our staff is here to connect your child with available resources. For students with insurance or other coverage such as CHIP, Medicaid or JPS Connection, the standard co-pay and PCP restrictions still apply.
