- Guests will park in the parking lot just in front of the Teacher Training Center, located at the College Street entrance on the East side of the building.
- A screening area will be set up at the entrance of the Teacher Training Center where the event will be held.
- All guests, adults, and children will be screened prior to entry to the Teacher Training Center and the screening data will be documented for contact tracing purposes only.
- All adults will be required to wear a mask or face covering brought from home. (Masks will not be provided at the door.)
- Children are encouraged to wear masks when developmentally tolerated.
- One parent/guardian per child will be allowed to enter the building.
- The number of guests inside the Teacher Training Center at any given time will be limited to 20 or less.
- **Save a Smile will be onsite and they will be able to provide free limited oral evaluations (dental screenings) and free oral health kits for students.**

Details:

- Keller ISD Students Only
- Current vaccine record (or note from school stating missing immunizations) is required.
- Parent or guardian must be present.
- Children 4-18 years can be seen. This should not replace any well-child checkups at the pediatrician.
- Older children who resist shots or children with special needs will not be seen given the nature of this clinic. Please refer to your pediatrician.
- Vaccines available: Chicken Pox, DtaP, Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, Hib, Meningococcal, MMR, Polio, Pneumonia, and TDaP
- Staff and supplies are limited, and there is no guarantee you will be seen. The clinic is on a first-come basis and may be discontinued when supplies or time run out.

Forms of Payment:

- **Aetna, Blue Cross Blue Shield, Cigna, Humana & United Health Care PPO plans will be accepted.**
WE CANNOT ACCEPT AETNA & BLUE CROSS GOLD, SILVER, OR BRONZE PLANS OR HMO PLANS WITH ANY INSURANCE COMPANY.
- A paper photo copy of insurance card and driver's license MUST be provided to receive vaccines at no charge. Electronic copies cannot be accepted.
- **Medicaid/CHIP:** No charge for vaccines. Must provide a paper photo copy of card.
- **UNINSURED:** \$10.00 PER VACCINE (\$40 max per child.)
- **CASH OR CHECK ONLY PLEASE (We cannot accept bills over \$20.)**
