As a district of innovation, the District shall be exempt from provisions requiring that a student assigned to a disciplinary alternative education program (DAEP) receive instruction in a setting other than the student's regular classroom.

Generally, students who are assigned to the DAEP shall be separated from students who are not assigned to the program. If a student's graduation plan will be negatively impacted by the DAEP placement, a committee will-shall determine which required courses for graduation or pathway completion the student may return to his or her home-home campus to complete. The committee will-shall be comprised composed of at least a one campus administrator from the student's home campus, a DAEP administrator, a classroom teacher, and a district-District administrator. The committee will-shall consider any concerns expressed by the teacher(s), the student's academic standing, the student's disciplinary history, and other mediating-mitigating factors. The District may revoke a student's privilege of attending campuses-classes on his or her home campus during a DAEP placement at any time.
