## What are my options?

**1**

You can always ask to meet with your child's principal, teacher, or librarian to discuss your options.

**2**

You can ask your child's teacher to share the books being assigned for class. If you have concerns you can ask that your child have an alternate assignment.

**3**

You can give the campus librarian a list of books you do not want your child to be able to check out. They are happy to help you!

**4**

If you believe the book is inappropriate for all students (not just your child) you can formally challenge the book.
