**NEW! Visiting Your Child for Lunch –** For the safety of our students, parents/guardians may <u>only</u> bring outside food for their own child(ren), and cannot provide outside food to other students. In addition, parents are only permitted to eat lunch with their own child, and **cannot** invite additional children to join them for lunch. Thank you for honoring these important safety practices.

**NEW! Fall Severe Weather Season** – As we transition to Fall, thunderstorms are more likely to affect our afternoon dismissal, and we want all families, students, and staff to be weather aware. If lightning or other adverse conditions are present, all outdoor activities will cease, including the loading of buses and the release of students.

During a "Severe Weather Dismissal," all students are held in their homeroom class except those whose parents have signed a severe weather waiver. Throughout the duration of the weather event, non-waiver students remain in their homeroom class unless they are checked out by a parent. Once the severe weather subsides, students will once again be allowed to exit the building independently.
