Deliveries – The convenience of delivery options has grown tremendously; however, Parkwood Hill Intermediate does not accept food, balloon, flower, or similar meal/gift deliveries for students. Please do not schedule and/or send items to be delivered to your child at school. If a parent wishes to personally drop off a set of sealed, store-bought cupcakes/cookies for their child's birthday, they may do so; however, such items can only be served at the very end of the school day, and will only be served if there are enough for every child in the class to partake.

Visiting Your Child for Lunch – For the safety of our students, parents/guardians may *only* bring outside food for their own child(ren), and cannot provide outside food to other students. In addition, parents are only permitted to eat lunch with their own child, and *cannot* invite additional children to join them for lunch. Thank you for honoring these important safety practices.
