

Scholarship Announcement

The Keller Police Association Scholarship provides scholarship assistance to students of Keller High School in Keller, Texas. Scholarships are available for students pursuing a secondary degree from an accredited college or university.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be considered for this scholarship, you must:

- 1. Be a resident of Keller, Texas and attended Keller High School (minimum of one year).
- 2. A graduating Keller High School senior.
- 3. Applied for full time enrollment to attend:
 An accredited junior or community college in the United States, or an accredited four-year college or university in the United States.
- 4. Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher

SELECTION PROCESS

The Scholarship Committee will consider the following criteria in making their selection:

- 1. Academic achievement
- 2. A letter of recommendation from someone other than a family member. Recommendations from school staff, leader of charity organization / club, or employment supervisor are preferred.
- 3. Statement of educational goals and career objectives
- 4. Completed Keller Police Association Scholarship application form

DEADLINE TO APPLY

May 15, 2024

Applications received after that deadline will not be considered.

NOTIFICATION

Scholarship winner will be notified by the KPA at a later date.

NUMBER OF AWARDS

Varies - Based on the availability of funds.



AMOUNT OF AWARDS

Varies - Based on the availability of funds.

METHOD OF DISBURSEMENT

Awards are paid in one installment and mailed directly to the college or university of enrollment.

SCHOLARSHIP DURATION

The Keller Police Association scholarship is a one-time award. To remain eligible for the Keller Police Association scholarship, you must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or higher.

REVOCATION OF SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship may be revoked by the Board of Directors for the Keller Police Association Scholarship for any of the following reasons:

- 1. Student fails to complete enrollment into an accredited college or university.
- 2. Student placed on academic probation by the college may be retained on scholarship for one term (semester or quarter). If at the end of this term, they are not removed from probation by the college or university, the scholarship and future payments are automatically revoked.
- 3. Student suspended from the college for academic or other reasons will have their scholarship automatically revoked, effective the date of suspension even though they may be re-admitted by the college.
- 4. Any act of misconduct which would bring discredit to the image of the scholarship is subject to review by the KPAS Board of Directors and possible revocation.
