Updates:

- Per the District of Innovation adjustments, a statement has been added to clarify out-of-school suspensions for K-2 students:

A student in grade two or below shall not be placed in out-of-school suspension for more than ten days in one school year and may not be suspended for more than two days in a row unless there are extenuating circumstances.

- For purposes of increasing the number of students DAEP is able to serve at the high school level, new designations of grade levels for elementary and secondary have been established.

Elementary DAEP will be grades K-8 with sub designations of K-3 and 4-8. High School DAEP will be grades 9-12.

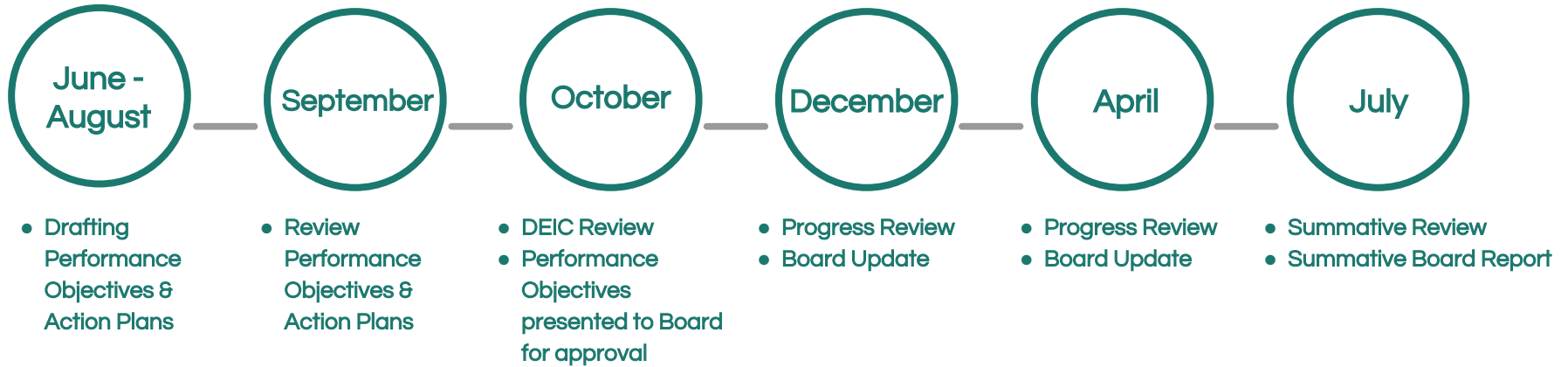

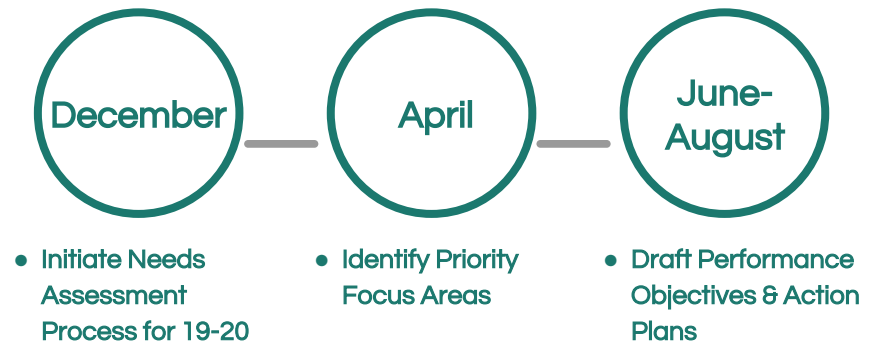

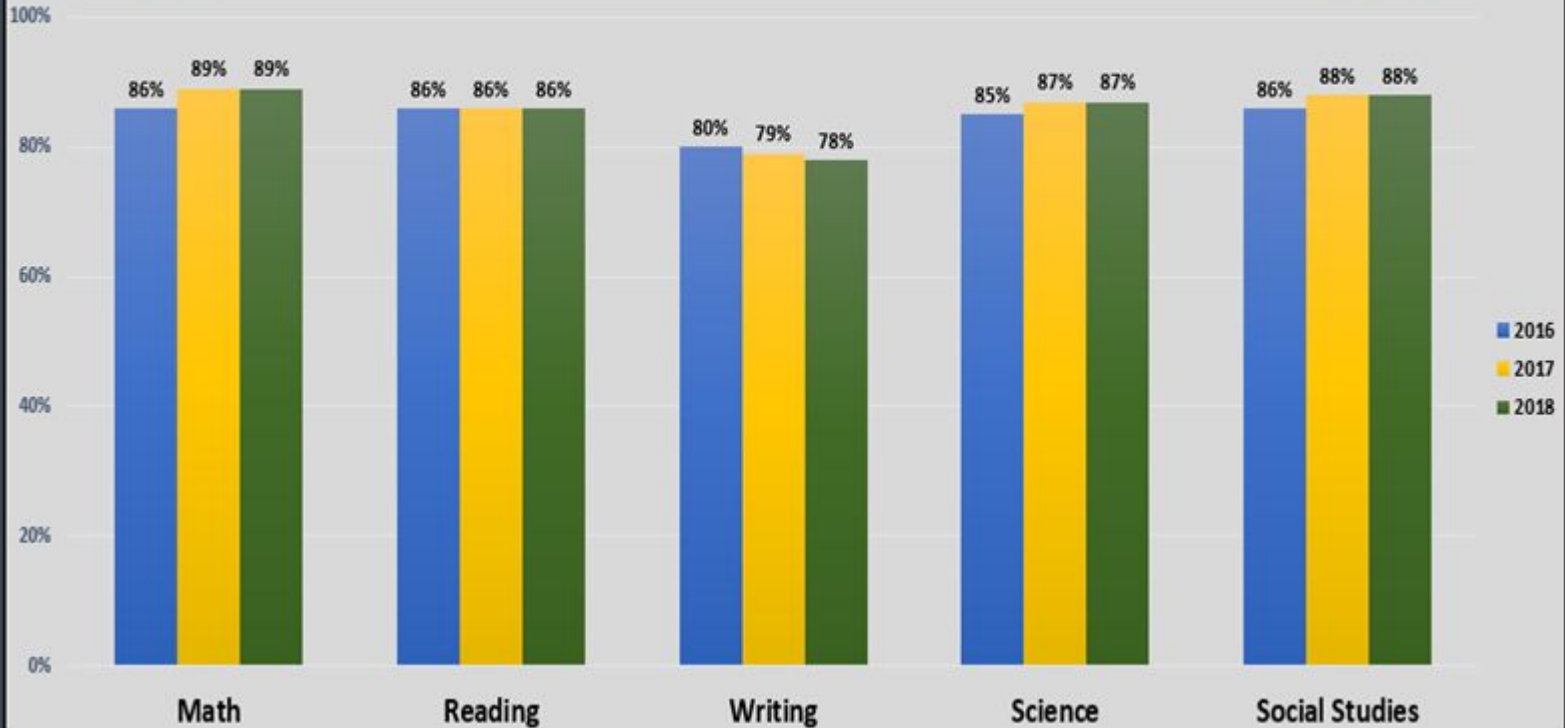
