Subject: SAT & ACT Testing - Spring 2020

Keller ISD is excited to offer both the SAT and ACT during the school day this spring for **Juniors** and **Seniors**. The ACT will be administered on February 25, 2020 and the SAT will be administered on March 4, 2020.

Students will have the opportunity to take one national assessment at no charge. If students would like to take both the SAT and ACT during the school day, the student will be charged \$65.00 for one exam. Juniors and Seniors will need to register for the exam that they would like to take during the school day through the KISD webstore. Registration will open November 18th at 8:00 a.m. and close on January 24th at 4:00 p.m.

Actions that families need to take:

- If your student would like to take one exam, no charge will be applied. If your student would like to take both exams, a fee of \$65 will be applied.
- Visit the **KELLER ISD WEBSTORE** to register. This step is required if you are taking one or both national exams this spring. This is the only registration process. Once you hit submit on the webstore, you will be signed up for the exam(s) that you have selected.
- Payment: If you choose to take both exams, you will need to pay \$65. You can pay online at the webstore when you register, or if you would like to pay with cash or a check, you may pay in person with Mrs. Jennifer Cizek from 8-8:30 AM in the front office.

The SAT and ACT are each accepted at all U.S. colleges and measure what students are learning in high school and what they need to know to succeed in college and beyond.. KISD is excited to offer this opportunity to students during the school day, allowing students to be more comfortable and confident by testing in a familiar setting.
